2021-2022 School Year Report

The vision of Borger Independent School District's Student Health Advisory Council is to promote health and wellness in our community.

- 1. The SHAC recommends that Borger ISD utilize the state adopted health curriculum of Quaver ED for kindergarten to 5th grade and curriculum by Goodheart-Willcox in 6th grade to Health 2 to address the Human Sexuality TEKS. Additionally, SHAC recommends that we continue with the appropriate videos selected by the school nurses and campus principals in 4th and 5th grade to address the Human Sexuality TEKS in those grade levels. Students will not be exposed any material related to the human sexuality TEKS unless a parent has decided to Opt-In to the instruction for their child per Board policy and HB 1525 of the 87th Legislative Session.
- 2. There are no modifications to the SHAC recommendations, at this time.
- 3. During the 2021-2022 School Year, the SHAC committee met a total of 5 times as a council and had 7 additional subcommittee meetings. Below is a description of what was explained at each gathering:
