The band would like to thank the administration of Borger ISD, Borger High School, the band boosters and their parents, and the Borger community for the support shown for them this marching season.

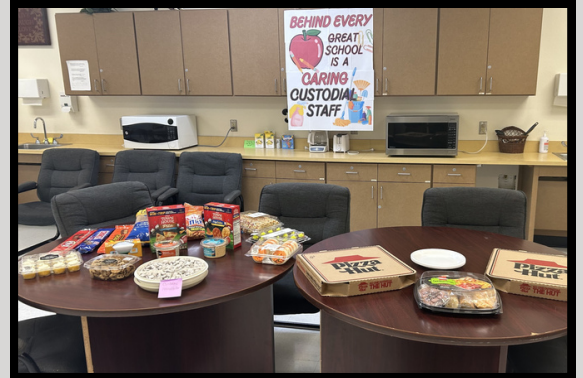
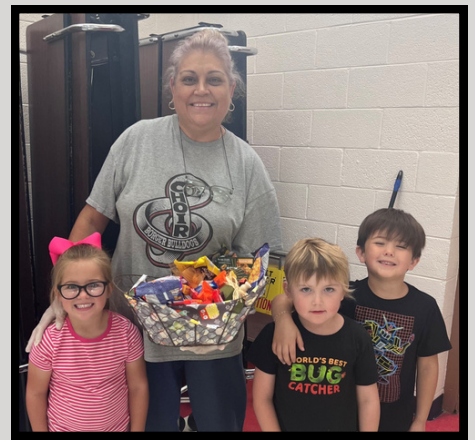
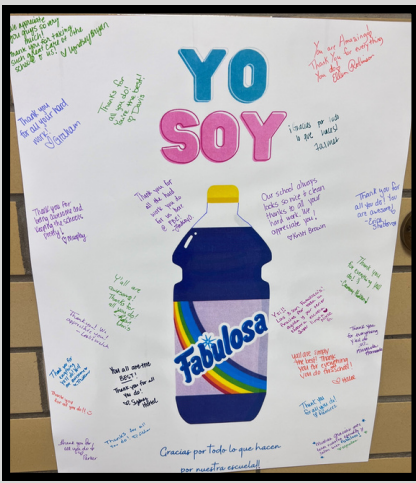

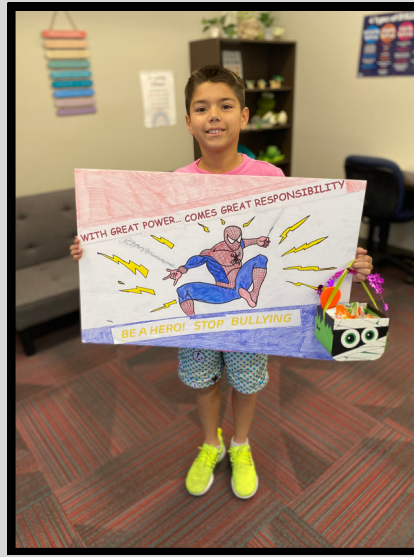
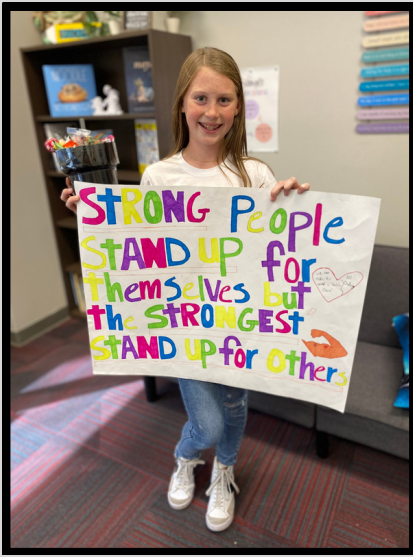


The Borger Fire Department presented an amazing Fire Safety session at Paul Belton Elementary! Our Little Bulldogs had a blast and learned so much about staying safe.
