The Administration Building had a Thankful Bulletin Board in November. Staff members wrote about people and things they are thankful for.



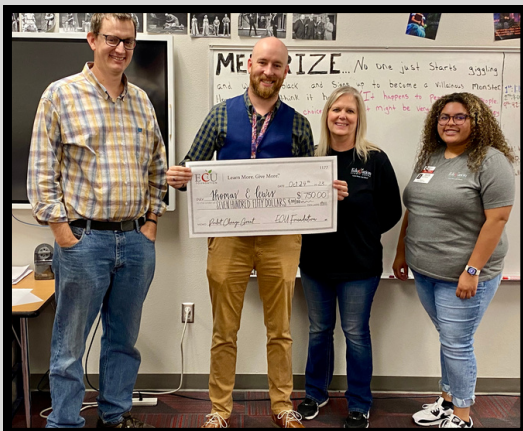
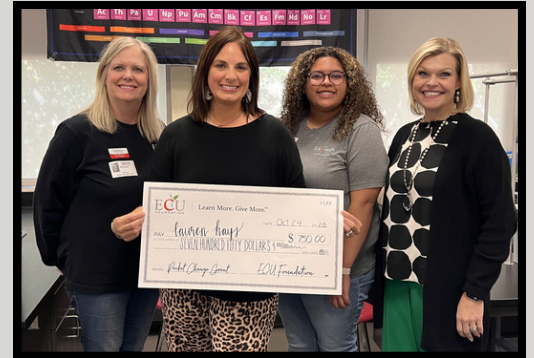
# Education Credit Union Awarded Borger ISD Teachers with Pocket Change Grants!

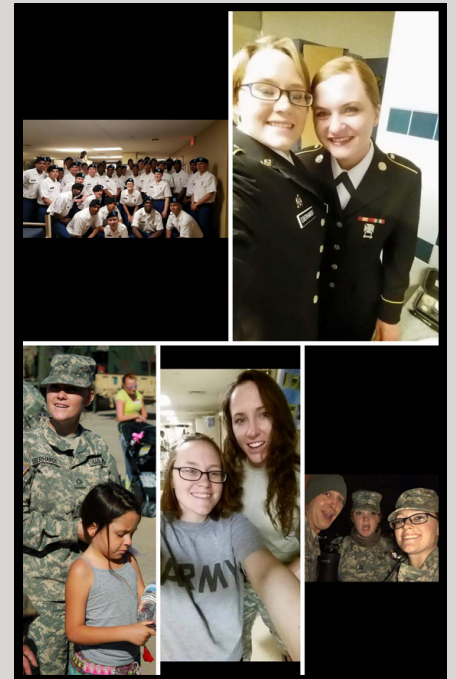
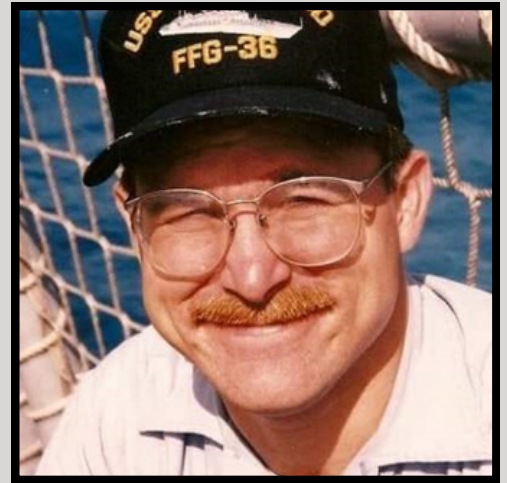
