

PUBLIC COMMENT at BOARD MEETINGS

DESIGNATED TIME FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

The PUBLIC COMMENT portion of the Board Meeting will begin at 6:00 P.M., as the law now requires public comment on agenda items to be held PRIOR to a Board's action on those items. The Board will have PUBLIC COMMENT at 6:00, for as long as necessary to hear the comments, then go into Closed Session for approximately one hour, reconvening immediately thereafter to continue the meeting.

SPEAKER SIGN-UP

Individuals who wish to participate during the portion of the meeting designated for public comment shall sign up with the presiding officer or designee before the meeting begins as specified in the Board's procedures on public comment and shall indicate the agenda item on which they wish to address the Board.

In the interest of time and the orderly conduct of public business, *the Board reserves the right to:*

- establish a time limit to address the board, including adjusting the time limit up or down;
- recommend that comments involving the performance of individual District employees or officers be made through the grievance policy;
- require that comments involving personally identifiable student information be made through the grievance process;
- continue a meeting or an agenda item to another day in order to allow adequate time for public comment.

PER SPEAKER TIME LIMIT

An individual's comments to the Board shall not exceed three minutes.

WRITTEN SUBMISSIONS

NOTE: Written submissions are subject to Public Disclosure, in accordance with the law.
